Institutional Membership Fees

Just as an initiate pays a lifetime membership fee to become a member, circles (institutions really) must pay the annual institutional dues to maintain affiliation and be considered active. The institutional membership fee is the only continuing fee we charge. Membership has its obligations as well as its privileges.

The deadline for the FY 2019-20 Institutional Membership Fees is May 31, 2020. Because of the pandemic and the difficulty many circles have had accessing accounts, we have extended the deadline to June 30, 2020. If your circle has not paid the FY 2020 OΔK Institutional Membership Fee (\$115), please do so as quickly as possible.

The Circle Annual Report is required according to the OΔK Policies and Procedures Handbook, and it must be completed by each circle. The Circle Annual Report is not just a formality to give circle advisors more work to do. It is a critical information-gathering tool for the Society.

In FY 2019, we only had 44% of active circles submit an annual report. We should have 100%, but our goal for FY 2020 is at least 75%.

The deadline for Circle Annual Reports has been extended to Tuesday, June 30, 2020.

National Headquarters Staff Keeps Things Moving

The Virginia stay-at-home order through June 10, 2020, is still in place. The National Headquarters staff continues to use a combination of staggered hours and virtual work strategies. We make every effort to respond quickly to certificate orders, requests for membership assistance, and business inquiries. We continue striving to provide high-quality service even as we are following distancing and health guidelines.

Over the past nine weeks, we have conducted two national virtual initiation ceremonies, two circle virtual initiation ceremonies, mailed more than 900 parcels with certificates and pins, helped circles get cords and stoles to graduates, and processed 1212 online membership payments (a 76% increase over FY 2019), published the spring issue of [The Circle](#), and continued to support our committees and volunteers.
