

Custom Initiate Questions for MyODK Applications

(Revised 1/15/2025)

Below is the list of approved questions that a circle may add to the standard ODK National Application. Please note, when added to the application, these questions become required.

Items with a caret (^) will appear only for student applications

Items with a hash (#) will appear only for non-student applications

Items marked with + will be included in the standard application beginning in February 2025 and will be removed from this list.

The items in red are the question that the ODK National Headquarters recommends based on an extensive review of applications and acceptances over that past three years.

The following questions are available to Circles to select for their application. We recommend circle minimize the number of items listed. Remember, the purpose of these questions is to ascertain if the applicant is a leader on campus. Determining leadership activity does not require extensive details.

3. Are you a full-time student (enrolled in 12 credit hours or more each semester)? ^
4. What is your course schedule this semester? ^
 - a. (Please list course numbers/names, professors' names, class meeting days/times, building/room numbers.)
5. In which college or school are you enrolled (e.g. Arts and Sciences, Business)? ^
6. What year and semester did you first enroll as a student our institution? (Ex: Fall 2021) ^
7. Add a link to your online resume
8. Please include your LinkedIn Public Profile URL
9. **Grade Point Average - GPA ^ (+)**
10. **Please list in detail your academic and professional organization memberships, leadership positions held, as well as awards and honors received. Do not include activities as a college student. # (250 words max.)**
